### **Background**

The periodically convoked international Sustainable Building conferences (SB) are one of the most important works of the international Green Building Challenge. Since 1998 the first SB98 were launched in Vancouver, the biyearly worldwide SB conferences became a global ceremony. Thousands of Experts and professionals go together, discussing and sharing the latest Information and Progress, so as to accelerate the development of the international Sustainable Building technology.

To develop Sustainable Building in the whole world, SB Conferences are now held every 3 years. SB05 will be convoked in September in Tokyo, Japan. As a part of SB05 activities, CIB and iiSBE plan to launch a series of regional/continental conferences in Africa, China, Latin America and the Caribbean, South East Asia, and Central / Eastern Europe in 2004.

#### **SB04 China**

The Chinese Conference on Sustainable Building will be held in Shanghai, in September 2004, simultaneously to two major construction-related events. It is expected that the main participating Provinces/Cities in the Chinese event include Beijing, Shanghai, Guangdong, Hunan, Liaoning, Henan, Jiangsu, among others. Shanghai is a metropolitan, easy to get to location in east China, and very well served in terms of infrastructure for major conferences.

**Stream 6: Sustainable infrastructure and public transport;**

**Stream 7: Strategies, policies and programs for Sustainable Building;**

**Stream 8: Regional best practices .**
